



2+2 Articulation Agreement Between
Wichita State University Bachelor of Science in Health Management
and Garden City Community College Associate of Science in Cybersecurity
May 20, 2025

The purpose of this 2+2 agreement is to provide Garden City Community College (GCCC) students who earn an Associate of Science (AS) in Cybersecurity the opportunity to transfer coursework from GCCC to Wichita State University (WSU) in pursuit of a baccalaureate degree with a major in Health Management.

This agreement is for GCCC students who have:

- Earned an Associate of Science
- Achieved a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0
- Applied for admission to WSU

GCCC students meeting the above requirements will:

- Be guaranteed admission to WSU with completion of application requirements and receipt of transcripts.
- Enter with junior status toward a baccalaureate degree.
- Be guaranteed to transfer all earned credits (100 level and higher) from GCCC with an earned grade of a C- or better. Classes accepted as part of the Health Management degree are noted on the attached program plan.

Students can inquire about academic and participation scholarships, financial aid, and grants by contacting the WSU Financial Aid offices (316-978-3430) or GCCC Financial Aid office (620 276-9519).

For graduation from WSU with a Health Management degree, students will need to fulfill transfer coursework from GCCC along with all WSU general education requirements, degree requirements, and must meet all requirements for graduation as outlined by WSU.

Additional Graduation Requirements:

1. For all bachelor's degrees granted by WSU, at least 30 credit hours must be earned at WSU. In addition, at least 24 of the last 30 credit hours applied towards the degree must be completed at WSU.
2. WSU requires a minimum of 45 upper-division credit hours.
3. WSU requires a minimum of 120 total hours to graduate. This includes any transferred hours from a regionally accredited school.

Students transferring to WSU from GCCC who have not completed the Associate of Science in Cybersecurity must meet the necessary requirements for admission to WSU, and will have their transcript evaluated on an individual basis.

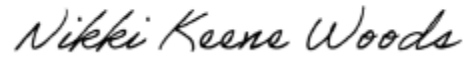
